## The Animal Welfare Association offers pet owners discounted neuter surgeries during month of January

## "Happy Neuter Year" Sponsored by PetSmart Charities®,

**Voorhees, NJ (January 6, 2014)** – The Animal Welfare Association (AWA) wants pet owners to ring in the New Year by making a resolution to neuter their male dogs and cats and is offering a great bargain called the **"Happy Neuter Year"** campaign. Sponsored by <u>PetSmart Charities</u>, the largest funder of animal welfare efforts in North America, the **"Happy Neuter Year"** campaign will provide \$20 neuter surgeries for male dogs and cats during the month of January.

Spaying and neutering is one of the most effective ways to reduce the homeless pet population and is safe for puppies and kittens as young as eight to ten weeks old, according to the American Veterinary Medical Association.

"Neutering male pets is a simple surgery that reduces unwanted behaviors, like roaming, fighting, and urine marking territories," says Maya Richmond, AWA's executive director, "and it guarantees dogs and cats never father a litter of puppies or kittens."

This special \$20 rate is even less than the organization's normal low-cost fee and is available to all residents of South Jersey. *Pet owners who wish to take advantage of this offer must mention the "Happy Neuter Year" campaign when they schedule their appointments.* This campaign is limited based on availability.
