**Important – Animal Alert. We need Camden County Residents' Support!**

This is an exciting time for community cats! We appreciate your attendance at February's Camden County Board of Freeholder's meeting on Thursday, February 16th at 7PM.

Freeholder Nash is proposing a County Resolution **in favor of Trap, Neuter and Return (TNR)** for community cats. Freeholder Nash is a strong advocate for animal welfare. He was instrumental in passing Norman's Law (banning of puppy mill-supplied dogs to pet stores in the county.)

Freeholder Nash's pro-TNR resolution calls for the end of the inhumane practice of rounding up and euthanizing outdoor cats. It favors allowing people to trap, neuter and return these cats to their colonies.

Camden County Board of Freeholders is once again leading the way for our community to provide for helpless animals.
